

Narrative writing

Intent

Inspired by the book 'The Wolf's Story' by Toby Forward and Izhar Cohen, we will have written a traditional tale from a different character's point of view and will read them to other children in EYFS and Year 1.



When writing we are going to:

Plan our writing:

- By planning or saying out loud what they are going to write about.
- By using a familiar story to plan a twist on the narrative.

Draft and write:

- By writing down ideas and/or key words, including new vocabulary
- Summarise what they want to say, sentence by sentence.
- By writing a simple, coherent narrative.
- By reading aloud what they have written with appropriate intonation to make the meaning clear.

Evaluate and edit:

- Identify the strengths and targets of their writing with the teacher and other pupils.
- Check that verbs to indicate time are used correctly and consistently, including verbs in the continuous form
- Correct most errors in capital letters and full stops.
- Correct taught spellings.

Grammar

Spelling focuses:

- To spell more common exception words from the Year 1/2 spelling list.
- To revise GPCs covered in Year 1.

Punctuation focuses:

- Use capital letters and full stops accurately.
- Use commas for a list of adjectives.

Sentence focuses:

- Use statements.
- Use expanded noun phrases to describe the five senses.
- Use past tense accurately.
- Use co-ordinating conjunctions: or, and, but
- Use subordinating conjunctions: because, if, then, that

and Spoken Language

- Listening to, discussing and expressing views about a wide range of contemporary and classic poetry, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which they can read independently.
- Becoming very familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics.

Discussing their favourite words and phrases.

To use language they've learnt in role play to retell a narrative.

To develop a plot through role play.
